

Yarmouth Town Hall Archaeology Exhibit

The Yarmouth Historical Commission and the Taylor-Bray Farm Preservation Association are sponsoring “Yarmouth’s Archaeological Past”, an exhibit of artifacts covering 10,000 years of town history. This exhibit is currently on display upstairs at Yarmouth Town Hall, 1146 MA-28, South Yarmouth, MA 02664. The focal point of the exhibit is a selection of artifacts discovered during several years of fieldwork at Taylor-Bray Farm which documented 10,000 years of human habitation at the farm from the earliest presence of Native peoples to a Plymouth Colony era farm that was placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1993. The exhibit also includes a collection of Native American projectile points discovered in West Yarmouth in the 1970s and donated to the Town of Yarmouth.
